# UCAS APPLY 2020 EX-STUDENTS INSTRUCTIONS

#### **KEY FACTS**

- Ex-students must still apply to UCAS through the college using the buzzword **varley28** to enable us to provide you with a reference. UCAS will then ask which group to allocate yourself you will be Ex-students 10s, 20s, 30s or 40s, depending on your tutor number when you were at PSC. Eg, E35 = Ex-students 30s or E1L = Ex-students 10s
- Before submitting the application, it is recommended that ex-students opt in to share the progress of their application with us on the declaration page. This will enable us to see progress in UCAS Adviser Track
- For help and information about applying to UCAS as an ex-student, please contact the
  Careers Department, NOT your former tutor or subject teachers although it is advised that
  you go through your college reference with your tutor before you leave to ensure it is up to
  date.
- Students are unable to take resits at Peter Symonds College our nearest examination centre for resit exams is Wessex Tutors in Southampton www.wessextutors.com
- We will provide predicted grades if you are resitting any courses at another examination centre these are usually a grade higher than your original results
- A number of universities have Compact Agreements with Peter Symonds College, enabling some students to receive a slightly reduced conditional offer or additional support, if they meet a certain set of criteria. Contact the Careers Department for further information.
- We will attempt to process late applications to meet the final UCAS deadline, but recommend that you work towards meeting our internal deadlines as set out below.

## Procedures for Applying to Higher Education at Peter Symonds College

Start UCAS form via www.ucas.co.uk using buzzword **varley28** 



Once form is completed, it is **your responsibility** to check your UCAS form



It is advisable to visit the Careers Department to have your form checked by a Careers Adviser before submitting your UCAS form



Click pay/send once you have checked your UCAS form (applicant fee is £25, paid online with debit/credit card)



The college will upload your reference and predicted grades (if relevant)



We will check your form for any major errors and contact you if any amendments are required



UCAS Administrators will aim to send your form to UCAS within 10 working days (term time only) if you meet the internal deadline (unless we come back to you with any queries)



UCAS forwards copies of your UCAS form to your chosen institutions and acknowledges receipt of your form via email
